AN ACT CONCERNING THE FILING PERIOD FOR CITY OFFICES
IN A CITY ADMINISTRATOR FORM OF GOVERNMENT; AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

CONCERNING THE FILING PERIOD FOR CITY
OFFICES IN A CITY ADMINISTRATOR FORM OF
GOVERNMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-48-109(a)(3), concerning the filing period in a city administrator form of government, is amended to read as follows:

(3) Any person desiring to become a candidate for mayor or director shall file with the city clerk not less than ~~seventy-(70)~~ seventy-five (75) days nor more than ninety (90) days prior to the primary election by 12:00 noon a statement of his or her candidacy in substantially the following form:

“STATE OF ARKANSAS
COUNTY OF

I,, being first duly sworn, state that I reside at
..... Street, City of, County and State aforesaid;
that I am a qualified elector of said city and the ward in which I reside;
that I am a candidate for nomination to the office of _____,
(Mayor) (Director)



to be voted upon at the primary election to be held on the
day of, 20....., and I hereby request that my name be placed
upon the official primary election ballot for nomination by such primary
election for such office and I herewith deposit the sum of ten dollars
(\$10.00), the fee prescribed by law.”;

*SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 14-48-109(a)(4), concerning candidacy in a
city administrator form of government, is amended to read as follows:*

*(4) The statement of candidacy and the petition for nomination
supporting the candidacy of each candidate to be voted upon at any general or
special election shall be filed with the city clerk or recorder not less than
~~seventy (70)~~ seventy-five (75) days nor more than ninety (90) days before the
election by 12:00 noon;*
