AN ACT TO AMEND THE DEFINITION OF "CHILD" FOR THE PURPOSE OF A STATE EMPLOYEE'S LEAVE FOR PARTICIPATION IN CHILDREN'S EDUCATIONAL LEAVE TO INCLUDE A DEVELOPMENTALLY DISABLED CHILD; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE DEFINITION OF "CHILD" FOR THE PURPOSE OF A STATE EMPLOYEE'S LEAVE FOR PARTICIPATION IN CHILDREN'S EDUCATIONAL LEAVE TO INCLUDE A DEVELOPMENTALLY DISABLED CHILD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 21-4-216(a)(1)(B), concerning the definition of "child" for purposes of a state employee's leave for participation in children's educational activities, is amended to read as follows:

(B) "Child" includes a person who meets the criteria of subdivision (a)(1)(A) of this section but is over eighteen (18) years of age and:

(i) ~~Over eighteen (18) years of age~~ Has a developmental disability as defined in § 20-48-101; and or

(ii) ~~Declared~~ Is declared legally incompetent;
