HOUSE BILL 1324

For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT CONCERNING AN OFFICER WHO DEFAULTS ON
DELIVERING AN EXECUTION; MAKING § 16-66-118
CONSISTENT WITH ACT 1151 OF 2003; EXTENDING THE TIME
PERIOD DURING WHICH EXECUTIONS ARE RETURNABLE; AND
FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

CONCERNING AN OFFICER WHO DEFAULTS ON
DELIVERING AN EXECUTION; EXTENDING THE
TIME PERIOD DURING WHICH EXECUTIONS ARE
RETURNABLE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The introductory language of Arkansas Code § 16-66-118(a), concerning an officer who defaults on delivering an execution, is amended to make the statute consistent with Act 1151 of 2003 to read as follows:

(a) Each officer to whom any execution is delivered shall be liable and bound to pay the whole amount of money specified in or endorsed on the execution and directed to be levied if he or she willfully:

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 16-66-416(a), concerning the returns of executions, is amended to read as follows:

(a) All executions shall be returnable ~~in sixty (60)~~ within ninety (90) days from their date.
