AN ACT TO RAISE THE ARKANSAS STATE MINIMUM WAGE FOR
EMPLOYEES OTHER THAN PART-TIME STUDENT EMPLOYEES; AND
FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO RAISE THE ARKANSAS STATE MINIMUM WAGE
FOR EMPLOYEES OTHER THAN PART-TIME
STUDENT EMPLOYEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 11-4-210 is amended to read as follows:
11-4-210. Minimum wage.

(a) Beginning October 1, ~~2006~~ 2013, every employer shall pay each of his or her employees wages at the rate of not less than ~~six dollars and twenty-five cents (\$6.25)~~ eight dollars and twenty-five cents (\$8.25) per hour except as otherwise provided in this subchapter.

(b) With respect to any full-time student attending any accredited institution of education within this state and who is employed to work an amount not to exceed twenty (20) hours during weeks that school is in session or forty (40) hours during weeks when school is not in session, the rate of wage shall be equal to but not less than ~~eighty-five percent (85%)~~ sixty-five percent (65%) of the minimum wage provided in this section.
