CONCERNING THE ANNUAL VACATION OF FIRE
DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-53-107 is amended to read as follows:
14-53-107. Annual vacation.

The chief of the fire department shall ~~se~~ arrange ~~that~~ for each
employee ~~shall to~~ be granted an annual vacation of not less than ~~fifteen (15)~~
~~days~~ the equivalent of three (3) calendar weeks with full pay.

SECTION 2. DO NOT CODIFY. EFFECTIVE DATE.

The effective date of this act is January 1, 2015.
