AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHILD PASSENGER PROTECTION ACT;
TO RAISE THE AGE AND WEIGHT REQUIREMENTS FOR CHILD
PASSENGER SAFETY SEATS AND SAFETY BELTS; AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES.

TO AMEND THE CHILD PASSENGER PROTECTION
ACT; AND TO RAISE THE AGE AND WEIGHT
REQUIREMENTS FOR CHILD PASSENGER SAFETY
SEATS AND SAFETY BELTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-34-104(b) and (c), concerning safety seat and safety belt requirements under the Child Passenger Protection Act, are amended to read as follows:

(b) *A Unless a child is at least four feet nine inches (4' 9") tall, a child who is less than ~~six (6)~~ nine (9) years of age and who weighs less than ~~sixty pounds (60 lbs.)~~ eighty pounds (80 lbs.) shall be restrained in a child passenger safety seat properly secured to the vehicle.*

(c) *If a child is at least ~~six (6)~~ nine (9) years of age ~~or~~ and at least ~~sixty pounds (60 lbs.)~~ eighty pounds (80 lbs.) in weight or is at least four feet nine inches (4' 9") tall, a safety belt properly secured to the vehicle shall be sufficient to meet the requirements of this section.*
