AN ACT TO INCREASE THE PUBLIC SWIMMING POOL PERMIT FEES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO INCREASE THE PUBLIC SWIMMING POOL PERMIT FEES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-30-106 is amended to read as follows:
20-30-106. Permits – Fees.

(a)(1) The annual permit fee to operate a public swimming pool shall be twenty-five dollars (\$25.00), ~~except as outlined in subsection (b) of this section,~~ due and payable each January 1.

(2) The permit fee shall be due and payable prior to beginning operation of any new public swimming pool and on each January 1 thereafter.

(3) Each body of water operated at a common facility shall be permitted as a separate public swimming pool.

~~(b) If a public swimming pool and a food service establishment are owned and operated at the same location by a common individual, corporation, firm, or other entity, the annual swimming pool permit fee shall be ten dollars (\$10.00) due and payable each January 1.~~

~~(e)~~(b) The permit fee shall be paid to the Division of Health of the Department of Health and Human Services before a permit is issued, and the permit shall be kept and displayed in a conspicuous manner, properly framed, at the pool for which it was issued.
