CONCERNING THE USE OF PAPER BALLOTS OR ELECTRONIC

PURPOSES.

TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS TO THE LAW
CONCERNING THE USE OF PAPER BALLOTS OR
ELECTRONIC VOTING MACHINES IN A SCHOOL
ELECTION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-14-102(c)(2)(B), concerning ballots for a school election, is amended to read as follows:

(B) ~~In~~ If a county ~~that~~ uses electronic voting machines or electronic vote tabulating devices, the county board of election commissioners may ~~choose to use paper;~~

(i) The electronic voting machines or electronic vote tabulating devices; or

(ii) Paper ballots counted by hand and ~~may~~ provide ~~that~~ no voting machines ~~shall~~ to be used in the election, notwithstanding any other provision in the Arkansas Code.
