AN ACT TO REMOVE THE REQUIREMENT FOR TUBERCULOSIS  
TESTING OF HOME HEALTH WORKERS; AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

TO REMOVE THE REQUIREMENT FOR  
TUBERCULOSIS TESTING OF HOME HEALTH  
WORKERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 20, Chapter 10, Subchapter 8, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

20-10-814. Tuberculosis tests of home health workers.

(a) The Department of Health shall not require a home health worker to be tested for tuberculosis.

(b) The State Board of Health shall adopt rules to implement this section.
