AN ACT TO REPEAL THE EXEMPTION OF REAL ESTATE AGENTS FROM THE WORKERS' COMPENSATION LAW THAT RESULTED FROM INITIATED MEASURE 4 OF 1948; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO REPEAL THE EXEMPTION OF REAL ESTATE AGENTS FROM THE WORKERS' COMPENSATION LAW.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 11-9-102(9)(B), concerning the definition of employee for the Workers' Compensation law that resulted from Initiated Measure 4 of 1948, is repealed.

~~(B) The term "employee" shall not include any individual who is both a licensee as defined in § 17-42-103(7) and a qualified real estate agent as that term is defined in section 3508(b)(1) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, including all regulations thereunder.~~
