AN ACT CONCERNING THE CRIMINAL OFFENSE OF THEFT BY
RECEIVING; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

CONCERNING THE CRIMINAL OFFENSE OF THEFT
BY RECEIVING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-36-106(e), concerning the penalties for and elements constituting theft by receiving, is amended to read as follows:

(e) Theft by receiving is a:

(1) Class B felony if the value of the property is twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) or more;

(2) Class C felony if:

(A) the The value of the property is less than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) but more than five thousand dollars (\$5,000); or

(B) The property is a firearm valued at two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) or more;

(3) Class D felony if:

(A) The value of the property is five thousand dollars (\$5,000) or less but more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000);

(B) The property is a:

(i) Credit card or credit card account number; ~~or~~

(ii) Debit card or debit card account number; or

(iii) Firearm valued at less than two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500); or



(4) Class A misdemeanor if otherwise committed.
