HOUSE BILL 1948

For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS EXISTING WORKFORCE TRAINING ACT OF 1995; TO RAISE THE PAY FOR INSTRUCTIONAL HOURS FROM EIGHTY DOLLARS PER HOUR TO ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS PER HOUR; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS EXISTING WORKFORCE TRAINING ACT OF 1995; AND TO RAISE THE PAY FOR INSTRUCTIONAL HOURS FROM EIGHTY DOLLARS PER HOUR TO ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS PER HOUR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-50-704(b)(3)(B)(ii)(a), concerning the instruction hour rate, is amended to read as follows:

(ii)(a) The instructional hour rate established by the governing council, not to exceed ~~eighty dollars (\$80.00)~~ one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per instructional hour, times the number of instructional hours delivered with fifty percent (50%) or more of the eligible participants completing the course.
