BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-9-106, concerning the selection and training requirements for a law enforcement officer, is amended to add a new subsection to read as follows:

(f) A constable who has completed the requisite training to qualify for an Originating Agency Identifier number from the Federal Bureau of Investigation shall be considered a certified law enforcement officer.
