HOUSE BILL 2117

## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THAT THE GOVERNING BODY OF A  
POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OR A PUBLICLY-FUNDED ENTITY HAS  
A REPRESENTATIVE FORM OF GOVERNMENT; AND FOR OTHER  
PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO REQUIRE THAT THE GOVERNING BODY OF A  
POLITICAL SUBDIVISION OR A PUBLICLY-  
FUNDED ENTITY HAS A REPRESENTATIVE FORM  
OF GOVERNMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to modify the law in Arkansas to require that the governing body of a political subdivision or a publicly-funded entity has a representative form of government and to repeal any at-large positions and replace those positions with ward positions.
