HOUSE BILL 2126

For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REVOKE THE PERMIT OF AN ON-PREMISES
CONSUMPTION PERMIT HOLDER UPON THE PERMIT HOLDER'S
SECOND VIOLATION OF THE RULES OF THE ALCOHOLIC
BEVERAGE CONTROL DIVISION AND STATE LAW REGARDING THE
SERVICE TO A MINOR AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO REVOKE THE PERMIT OF AN ON-PREMISES
CONSUMPTION PERMIT HOLDER UPON THE PERMIT
HOLDER'S SECOND VIOLATION OF THE RULES OF
THE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL DIVISION
AND STATE LAW REGARDING THE SERVICE TO A
MINOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 3, Chapter 9, Subchapter 1, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

3-9-102. Revocation of on-premises consumption permit for alcoholic beverages, wine, or beer.

(a) As used in this chapter:

(1) "Alcoholic beverages" means all intoxicating liquors of any sort, other than beer and wine;

(2) "Beer" means a fermented liquor made from malt or a malt substitute and having an alcoholic content not in excess of five percent (5%) by weight; and

(3) "Wine" means a port wine, sherry wine, vermouth wine, or



other wines, the alcoholic content of which does not exceed twenty-one percent (21%), regardless of where the wine is manufactured.

(b)(1) A permit issued pursuant to this act for on-premises consumption of alcoholic beverages, wine, or beer shall be revoked for cause for one (1) year upon the second violation in a calendar year of the rules of the Alcoholic Beverage Control Division or state law regarding a knowing or unknowing sale or service of alcoholic beverages, wine, or beer to a person less than twenty-one (21) years of age.

(2) The finding of a violation is to be made after a hearing under §§ 3-2-212-3-2-217, and the rules of the division.
