AN ACT TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS CODE CONCERNING GENERAL EDUCATIONAL DEVELOPMENT TESTING; TO ALLOW THE STATE BOARD OF CAREER EDUCATION TO CHARGE A FEE FOR ADMINISTERING TESTS AND OTHER EXPENSES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS CODE CONCERNING
GENERAL EDUCATIONAL DEVELOPMENT TESTING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-16-118 is amended to read as follows:

6-16-118. General Educational Development testing for adults - Fees.

(a) As used in this section, "general educational development test" means the General Education Development (GED) test of the GED Testing Service.

(b) The general educational development test for adults shall be administered by the educational agencies and institutions approved by the Department of ~~Workforce~~ Career Education ~~and the American Council on Education.~~

~~(b)(c) The State Board of Workforce Education and Career Opportunities is authorized to~~ State Board of Career Education may approve fees only for the administering of the test, not to exceed ten dollars (\$10.00) the first time and twenty dollars (\$20.00) for the second and subsequent tests for:

- (1) Administering the general educational development test;
- (2) Administering other assessments; and



- (3) Photocopying or duplicating a transcript or diploma.
- (d) The board shall promulgate rules to implement this section.
