HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

PROVIDING THAT THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL RECESS ON THURSDAY, JANUARY 17, 2013, AND RECONVENE ON TUESDAY, JANUARY 22, 2013.

PROVIDING THAT THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL RECESS ON THURSDAY, JANUARY 17, 2013, AND RECONVENE ON TUESDAY, JANUARY 22, 2013.

WHEREAS, the House of Representatives and the Senate will complete its work of the first week of the Eighty-Ninth General Assembly on Thursday, January 17, 2013; and

WHEREAS, Arkansas Code § 10-2-128 provides that in respect to Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., and in observation of his birthday, neither the House of Representatives nor the Senate shall convene in session nor shall any of their committees meet on the third Monday in January; and

WHEREAS, Monday, January 21, 2013, is the third Monday in January of 2013; and

WHEREAS, Article 5, Section 28, of the Arkansas Constitution provides that neither house of the General Assembly may adjourn for more than three (3) days without the consent of the other house; and



WHEREAS, the House of Representatives and the Senate of the Eighty-Ninth General Assembly wish to resume their work on Tuesday, January 22, 2013,

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

THAT the House of Representatives and the Senate will recess at the close of business Thursday, January 17, 2013, and reconvene on Tuesday, January 22, 2013.
