WHEREAS, junior setter Marissa Collins was named the Southland Conference's Setter of the Year for the second time and the fourth time in



five (5) years that the award has gone to a Sugar Bear; and

WHEREAS, Marissa Collins, Jessica Hays, and sophomore middle blocker Alicia Dittrich, earned First Team All-Southland Conference honors; and

WHEREAS, senior Taylor Hammonds earned All-Southland Conference Honorable Mention honors for the second time after ranking second in the conference with a .383 hitting percentage and leading the Sugar Bears with 71 blocks; and

WHEREAS, David McFatrigh, coach of the University of Central Arkansas Sugar Bears volleyball team, inspires his athletes to excellence by encouraging their focus on team, each other, and hard work; and

WHEREAS, sports and athletics are challenging and stimulating, and the continued success of the University of Central Arkansas Sugar Bears volleyball team is a tribute to their talent, hard work, and leadership, with the support of their families, friends, and the community,
