AN ACT TO REQUIRE AN INTERIM STUDY TO IMPROVE
SWIMMING POOL WATER QUALITY AND REDUCE RECREATIONAL
WATER ILLNESSES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO REQUIRE AN INTERIM STUDY TO IMPROVE
SWIMMING POOL WATER QUALITY AND REDUCE
RECREATIONAL WATER ILLNESSES.

WHEREAS, in states that have required that swimming pool operators be certified, swimming pool water quality has improved; and

WHEREAS, improved swimming pool water quality has helped to reduce recreational water illnesses that arise from general disinfection, water contamination, and surface contamination; and

WHEREAS, implementing the Disinfection and Water Quality Module from the upcoming Centers for Disease Control Model Aquatic Health Code would contribute to improved swimming pool water quality.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. DO NOT CODIFY. During the 2013-2014 interim, the House Committee on Public Health, Welfare, and Labor and the Senate Committee on Public Health, Welfare, and Labor shall study the benefits of:

(1) Having swimming pool operators be certified to maintain pools; and

(2) Implementing the Disinfection and Water Quality Module from



the upcoming Centers for Disease Control Model Aquatic Health Code.
