## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS LAW REGARDING CIVIL ACTIONS  
IN WHICH MONETARY DAMAGES ARE SOUGHT; REGARDING  
WITNESSES AND TESTIMONY; CONCERNING VENUE AND  
JURISDICTION; MODIFYING THE LIABILITY OF A PARTY TO A  
LAWSUIT; REGARDING THE ASSESSMENT OF FAULT AND  
NEGLIGENCE; CONCERNING A LAWSUIT'S COMPLAINT AND  
PLEADINGS; ADDRESSING STATUTES OF LIMITATION AND  
OTHER PROCEDURES IN CIVIL ACTIONS IN WHICH MONETARY  
DAMAGES ARE SOUGHT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO AMEND ARKANSAS LAW REGARDING CIVIL  
ACTIONS IN WHICH MONETARY DAMAGES ARE  
SOUGHT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to amend Arkansas law regarding civil actions in which monetary damages are sought, regarding witnesses and testimony, concerning venue and jurisdiction, modifying the liability of a party to a lawsuit, regarding the assessment of fault and negligence, concerning a lawsuit's complaint and pleadings, and addressing statutes of limitation and other procedures in civil actions in which monetary damages are sought.
