AN ACT TO AMEND THE OFFENSE OF CRIMINAL
IMPERSONATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND THE OFFENSE OF CRIMINAL
IMPERSONATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-37-208(b), concerning the offense of criminal impersonation in the second degree, is amended to read as follows:

(b)(1) A person commits criminal impersonation in the second degree if the person does an act in his or her pretended or assumed capacity or character with the purpose to injure, ~~or~~ defraud, harass, or intimidate another person and the actor:

(A) Assumes a false identity;

(B) Pretends to be a representative of a person or organization;

(C) Pretends to be an officer or employee of the government other than a law enforcement officer described in subsection (a) of this section; ~~or~~

(D) Pretends that he or she is a law enforcement officer when the person is not a law enforcement officer; or

~~(D)~~ (E) Pretends to have a handicap or disability.

(2) Criminal impersonation in the second degree is a Class A misdemeanor.
