AN ACT TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS TO TITLE 10 OF
THE ARKANSAS CODE CONCERNING THE ARKANSAS STATE
CLAIMS COMMISSION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS TO TITLE 10
OF THE ARKANSAS CODE CONCERNING THE
ARKANSAS STATE CLAIMS COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 10-3-314 is repealed because the subject matter of the section is more appropriately codified as § 19-10-212.

~~10-3-314. Report on claim filed with Arkansas State Claims Commission.~~

~~(a)(1) Except as provided by subsection (b) of this section, it is the intent of the General Assembly that when any state agency, board, commission, or institution of higher education admits liability to a claim filed with the Arkansas State Claims Commission and the claim involves a contract with a state agency, board, commission, or institution of higher education or the claim exceeds ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) that the agency, board, commission, or institution of higher education file a written report of the claim with the Litigation Reports Oversight Subcommittee of the Legislative Council.~~

~~(2) The report shall include a concise statement of facts with an explanation of the agency's liability.~~

~~(3) The report shall be filed with the Litigation Reports~~



~~Oversight Subcommittee of the Legislative Council within thirty (30) days after the claim has been adjudicated by the Arkansas State Claims Commission.~~

~~(b) The Arkansas Lottery Commission shall file its written report under subsection (a) of this section with the Arkansas Lottery Commission Legislative Oversight Committee.~~

SECTION 2. DO NOT CODIFY. The enactment and adoption of this act shall not repeal, expressly or impliedly, the acts passed at the regular session of the Eighty-Ninth General Assembly. All such acts shall have the full force and effect and, so far as those acts intentionally vary from or conflict with any provision contained in this act, those acts shall have the effect of subsequent acts and as amending or repealing the appropriate parts of the Arkansas Code of 1987.
