AN ACT TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS TO TITLE 17 OF
THE ARKANSAS CODE, CONCERNING PROFESSIONS,
OCCUPATIONS, AND BUSINESSES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS TO TITLE 17
OF THE ARKANSAS CODE, CONCERNING
PROFESSIONS, OCCUPATIONS, AND BUSINESSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 17-23-202(b), concerning registration as a dealer of precious metals, is amended to clarify that a local law enforcement agency may specify the information required from nonresident applicants to read as follows:

(b) A nonresident applicant shall provide the principal place of business without the state and such further information as the ~~department~~ local law enforcement agency may require for the administration of its duties under this chapter.

SECTION 2. DO NOT CODIFY. The enactment and adoption of this act shall not repeal, expressly or impliedly, the acts passed at the regular session of the Eighty-Ninth General Assembly. All such acts shall have the full force and effect and, so far as those acts intentionally vary from or conflict with any provision contained in this act, those acts shall have the effect of subsequent acts and as amending or repealing the appropriate parts



of the Arkansas Code of 1987.
