AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEFINITION OF "EXEMPT  
COMMODITIES AND SERVICES" IN THE ARKANSAS PROCUREMENT  
LAW; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

CONCERNING THE DEFINITION OF "EXEMPT  
COMMODITIES AND SERVICES" IN THE ARKANSAS  
PROCUREMENT LAW.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 19-11-203(14), concerning the definition of "exempt commodities and services" in the Arkansas Procurement Law, is amended to add three new subdivisions to read as follows:

(CC) Commodities and raw materials purchased by Arkansas Correctional Industries intended for use in goods for resale;

(DD) Commodities purchased by the Department of Correction for crop production, including without limitation fertilizers, seed, seedlings, and agricultural-related chemicals; and

(EE) Repair services for hidden or unknown damages to machinery already purchased;
