For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO CLARIFY THE POWER OF THE STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO MAKE PLANS COORDINATING STATE AND FEDERAL LAWS; TO AMEND VARIOUS PROVISIONS OF THE ARKANSAS COMPREHENSIVE TESTING, ASSESSMENT, AND ACCOUNTABILITY PROGRAM ACT; TO UPDATE THE SCHOOL RATING SYSTEM, ARKANSAS SCHOOL RECOGNITION PROGRAM, AND OTHER LAWS RELATING TO SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT TO CONFORM TO CURRENT PRACTICE AND FEDERAL LAW; TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS OPPORTUNITY PUBLIC SCHOOL CHOICE ACT OF 2004; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND STATUTORY PROVISIONS REGARDING STATE BOARD OF EDUCATION AUTHORITY TO COORDINATE IMPLEMENTATION OF STATE AND FEDERAL LAWS; AND TO AMEND LAWS CONCERNING SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT AND SCHOOL RECOGNITION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to update and amend statutory provisions regarding authority of the State Board of Education to make plans coordinating state and federal laws, and concerning school improvement and school recognition.
