TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE ELECTION
OF MEMBERS OF COUNTY BOARDS OF ELECTION
COMMISSIONERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 7-4-102(a), concerning election of members of a county board of election commissioners, is amended to read as follows:

(a)(1) In January of each odd-numbered year following the election of county committee officers, members of the county board of election commissioners shall be elected by their respective county committees.

(2)~~(A)~~ The membership of the county board shall be as follows:

~~(A)(i) Two (2) members elected by the county committee of the majority party; and~~

~~(B) One (1) member elected by the county committee of the minority party with the majority of members on the county quorum court; and~~

(ii) One (1) member elected by the county committee of the party with the next highest number of members on the county quorum court.

(B) If one (1) party does not have a majority of members of the county quorum court, the members of the county quorum court who are not members of the two (2) parties with the most members on the county court



shall choose one (1) of the two (2) parties with the most members on the county quorum court to determine membership on the county board.
