AN ACT TO ESTABLISH THE POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION AND
ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ACT OF 2013; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

Subtitle

THE POSTSECONDARY EDUCATION AND ECONOMIC
DEVELOPMENT ACT OF 2013.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Chapter 60, Subchapter 2, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

6-60-214. Access to postsecondary education.

(a) This act shall be known as the "Postsecondary Education and Economic Development Act of 2013".

(b) A person who has attended a secondary educational institution in Arkansas for at least three (3) years and who has either graduated from an Arkansas high school or received a general education diploma in the state is eligible to pay the in-state tuition rate at any state-supported institution of higher education he or she attends.

(c) In addition to the requirements under subdivision (b) of this section, a student without documented immigration status shall file an affidavit with the state-supported institution of higher education stating that the student has an intent to legalize his or her immigration status.

(d) The Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall promulgate rules necessary to implement this act.
