IDENTIFICATION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

IDENTIFICATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to amend the Arkansas Code provisions concerning voter identification.
