### **For An Act To Be Entitled**

AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT POSSESSION OF A FIREARM BY A PERSON OR IN A PERSON'S VEHICLE IS NOT A CRIMINAL OFFENSE UNLESS THE POSSESSION OF THE FIREARM SPECIFICALLY VIOLATES ANOTHER FEDERAL, STATE, OR LOCAL STATUTE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

### **Subtitle**

TO PROVIDE THAT POSSESSION OF A FIREARM BY A PERSON OR IN A PERSON'S VEHICLE IS NOT A CRIMINAL OFFENSE UNLESS THE POSSESSION OF THE FIREARM SPECIFICALLY VIOLATES ANOTHER FEDERAL, STATE, OR LOCAL STATUTE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

*SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 5, Chapter 73, Subchapter 1, is amended to add a new section to read as follows:*

*5-73-112. Possession of a firearm permitted.*

*Possession or constructive possession of a firearm by a person, including in the person's vehicle, is not a criminal offense unless the possession specifically violates:*

- (1) Federal law;*
- (2) State law; or*
- (3) Local ordinance.*
