SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION

TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION CONCERNING ELECTED STATE OFFICIALS; AND TO AMEND THE ARKANSAS CONSTITUTION CONCERNING ETHICS AND SERVICE OF ELECTED STATE OFFICIALS.

Subtitle

THE ARKANSAS ELECTED OFFICIALS ETHICS,
TRANSPARENCY, AND FINANCIAL REFORM
AMENDMENT OF 2014.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS AND BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES, A MAJORITY OF ALL MEMBERS ELECTED TO EACH HOUSE AGREEING THERETO:

THAT the following is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of the State of Arkansas, and upon being submitted to the electors of the state for approval or rejection at the next general election for Representatives and Senators, if a majority of the electors voting thereon at the election adopt the amendment, the amendment shall become a part of the Constitution of the State of Arkansas, to wit:

SECTION 1. This amendment shall be known and may be cited as "The Arkansas Elected Officials Ethics, Transparency, and Financial Reform Amendment of 2014."

SECTION 2. The purpose of this joint resolution is to amend the



Arkansas Constitution concerning elected state officials, including without limitation ethics and service of elected state officials.
