## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE JOINT RULES OF THE

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EIGHTY-NINTH GENERAL  
ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:

SECTION 1. Section 21 of the Joint Rules of the House of  
Representatives and the Senate of the Eighty-Ninth General Assembly of the  
State of Arkansas is amended to read as follows:

#### Joint Committee on Constitutional Amendments

Section 21. The Joint Committee on Constitutional Amendments shall  
consist of the members of the Senate Committee on State Agencies and  
Governmental Affairs and the members of the House Committee on State Agencies  
and Governmental Affairs. No proposed constitutional amendment shall be  
recommended to either house of the General Assembly except upon the  
affirmative vote of a majority of the Senate members of the Joint Committee  
on Constitutional Amendments and an affirmative vote of a majority of the  
House members of the Joint Committee on Constitutional Amendments. No  
resolution proposing a constitutional amendment shall be filed in either the



House of Representatives or the Senate after the thirty-first (31st) day of each regular session of the General Assembly. All resolutions proposing constitutional amendments shall be referred to the Joint Committee on Constitutional Amendments. Other resolutions proposing constitutional amendments shall not be reported to or considered by either house of the General Assembly until the original recommendations of the Joint Committee on Constitutional Amendments are disposed of by both Houses. A resolution proposing a constitutional amendment may be considered only during a regular session. The Joint Committee on Constitutional Amendments shall meet on the first (1st) Tuesday after the thirty-first (31st) day of each regular session of the General Assembly to establish a meeting calendar and meet regularly thereafter.
