AN ACT TO ALTER THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE STATE PARKS,
RECREATION, AND TRAVEL COMMISSION; TO AMEND THE LAW
CONCERNING THE STATE PARKS, RECREATION, AND TRAVEL
COMMISSION; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO ALTER THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE STATE
PARKS, RECREATION, AND TRAVEL COMMISSION;
AND TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING THE STATE
PARKS, RECREATION, AND TRAVEL COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-11-202(A)(3), concerning membership of the State Parks, Recreation, and Travel Commission, is amended to read as follows:

(3) ~~One~~ If one (1) or more commissioners emeriti is designated under § 15-11-203, one (1) or more ~~commissioner emeritus~~ commissioners emeriti.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 15-11-203 is amended to read as follows:
15-11-203. Commissioner emeritus.

(a) ~~Any A~~ person who has shall be known and designated as a "commissioner emeritus" if he or she:

(1) Has served, is now serving, or serves in the future as a member for the State Parks, Recreation, and Travel Commission, as established by §§ 15-11-201, 15-11-202, and 15-11-204 – 15-11-207, or its predecessor



~~commissions and who has served or serves;~~

(2) Has served for twenty-four (24) years as a member of the commission or its predecessor commissions shall be known and designated as a "commissioner emeritus".; and

(3) Was known and designated as a "commissioner emeritus" under this section on or before the effective date of this act.

(b) A commissioner emeritus shall serve as a member of the commission for the remainder of his or her life ~~and~~, shall be notified of all commission meetings, and is entitled to the same expenses and other allowances for attending commission meetings as is provided by law for other commission members.

~~(c) The Governor shall cause an appropriate commission to be prepared and issued to each commissioner emeritus of the commission. The commissioner emeritus shall file the commission with the Secretary of State and take the official oath of office before entering upon his or her duties as a commissioner emeritus.~~
