TO AMEND ARKANSAS LAW REGARDING THE
PROMULGATION OF CERTAIN ADMINISTRATIVE
RULES CONCERNING HEALTHCARE PROVIDERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 25, Chapter 15, Subchapter 2 is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

25-15-220. Review of certain rules concerning healthcare providers.

(a) A state agency desiring to promulgate a rule that provides for licensure of a profession, occupation, or class of healthcare providers not currently licensed or that expands the scope of a profession, occupation, or class of healthcare providers shall file the proposed rule with the Administrative Rules and Regulations Subcommittee of the Legislative Council before commencing the promulgation process.

(b) The subcommittee shall conduct a study of the necessity of the proposed rule.

(c) A state agency shall not promulgate a rule that provides for licensure of a profession, occupation, or class of healthcare providers not currently licensed or that expands the scope of a profession, occupation, or class of healthcare providers until the subcommittee has completed its study



of the necessity of the rule.
