HOUSE BILL 1190

For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT CONCERNING REQUIREMENTS FOR A CONCEALED CARRY PERMIT; CONCERNING A CONCEALED CARRY PERMIT FOR PERSONS BETWEEN EIGHTEEN AND TWENTY-ONE YEARS OF AGE WHO ARE CURRENT OR FORMER MILITARY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

CONCERNING REQUIREMENTS FOR A CONCEALED CARRY PERMIT; AND CONCERNING A CONCEALED CARRY PERMIT FOR PERSONS BETWEEN EIGHTEEN AND TWENTY-ONE YEARS OF AGE WHO ARE CURRENT OR FORMER MILITARY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-73-309(3), concerning the requirements for a person to be issued a concealed carry permit, is amended to read as follows:

(3) *Is ~~twenty-one (21) years of age or older at least:~~*

(A) Twenty-one (21) years of age; or

(B) Eighteen (18) years of age and is:

(i) Currently a federally recognized commissioned or noncommissioned officer or an enlisted member on active duty in the United States Armed Forces;

(ii) In the National Guard or a reserve component of the United States Armed Forces; or

(iii) A former member of the United States Armed



Forces that has been honorably discharged;
