CHARGE A REASONABLE FEE FOR NONCRIMINAL
FINGERPRINTING SERVICES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

TO ALLOW A LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY
TO CHARGE A REASONABLE FEE FOR
NONCRIMINAL FINGERPRINTING SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 12, Chapter 12, Subchapter 1, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

12-12-108. Noncriminal fingerprinting – Fee.

A local law enforcement agency may charge a reasonable fee for noncriminal fingerprinting services to offset the cost of expenses associated with offering a noncriminal fingerprinting service.
