BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-65-107 is amended to read as follows:

5-65-107. ~~Persons arrested to be tried on charges—No charges reduced~~
~~—Filing Officers to file citations immediately.~~

~~(a) A person arrested for violating § 5-65-103 shall be tried on those~~
~~charges or plead to those charges, and no such charges shall be reduced.~~

~~(b) Furthermore, when~~ When a law enforcement officer issues a citation
for violating § 5-65-103, the citation shall be filed with the court as soon
as possible.
