HOUSE BILL 1403

For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT CONCERNING THE FEES ASSESSED FOR AN ALCOHOL TREATMENT OR EDUCATION PROGRAM ORDERED FOR CERTAIN PERSONS ARRESTED FOR OR CONVICTED OF DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

CONCERNING THE FEES ASSESSED FOR AN ALCOHOL TREATMENT OR EDUCATION PROGRAM ORDERED FOR CERTAIN PERSONS ARRESTED FOR OR CONVICTED OF DRIVING WHILE INTOXICATED.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 5-65-115(a)(2), concerning the fee amounts assessed for an alcohol treatment and education program, is amended to read as follows:

(2)(A) The alcohol education program may collect a program fee of up to ~~one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125)~~ one hundred seventy-five dollars (\$175) per enrollee to offset program costs.

(B)(i) A person ordered to complete an alcohol education program under this section may be required to pay, in addition to the costs collected for education or treatment, a fee of up to ~~twenty-five dollars (\$25.00)~~ seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) to offset the additional costs associated with reporting requirements under this subchapter.

(ii) The alcohol education program shall report monthly to the Division of Behavioral Health Services all revenue derived



from this fee.
