# A Bill

HOUSE BILL 1460

## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE USE OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES ON PUBLIC STREETS AND HIGHWAYS IF THE DRIVER IS USING THE ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE TO TRAVEL WITHIN TEN MILES OF THE DRIVER'S HOME OR PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO AUTHORIZE THE USE OF ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLES ON PUBLIC STREETS AND HIGHWAYS IF THE DRIVER IS USING THE ALL-TERRAIN VEHICLE TO TRAVEL WITHIN TEN MILES OF THE DRIVER'S HOME OR PLACE OF EMPLOYMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-21-106(a), concerning the exceptions to operating an all terrain vehicle on a public street or highway is amended to add a new subdivision to read as follows:

(6) A person may operate an all-terrain vehicle on the public streets or highways if the all-terrain vehicle is used to travel within ten (10) miles of a person's primary place of:

(A) Residence; or

(B) Employment.
