HOUSE BILL 1542

For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER EDUCATION TO REPORT TUITION AND MANDATORY FEES, INCLUDING CHANGES, FOR EACH STATE-SUPPORTED INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER EDUCATION TO REPORT TUITION AND MANDATORY FEES, INCLUDING CHANGES, FOR EACH STATE-SUPPORTED INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-61-215 is amended to read as follows:

6-61-215. Student tuition and fees – Reporting.

~~*In order to promote a coordinated system of higher education in Arkansas and to assure an orderly and effective development of each of the publicly supported institutions of higher education, the Arkansas Higher Education Coordinating Board shall have the power and duty to establish the level of student fees for funding purposes for both in-state and out-of-state students for all public institutions of higher learning in the state. The level of fees shall be determined after careful study of fees charged in other states in similar institutions.*~~

Annually, by July 1, the Department of Higher Education shall report the tuition and mandatory fees charged to students, including all changes to



tuition and mandatory fees, for each state-supported institution of higher education to the House Committee on Education and the Senate Committee on Education.
