For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REQUIRE A COMPREHENSIVE ONLINE SURVEY TO BE CONDUCTED AND INCLUDED IN THE COMPREHENSIVE SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN DEVELOPED BY A SCHOOL DISTRICT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO REQUIRE A COMPREHENSIVE ONLINE SURVEY TO BE CONDUCTED AND INCLUDED IN THE COMPREHENSIVE SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN DEVELOPED BY A SCHOOL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-15-426(f), concerning school improvement plans, is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:

(3)(A) Include the results of a comprehensive online survey that is conducted annually by the school district for parents, students, licensed and classified public school staff, and community members to submit feedback to the school district in the areas of:

(i) Academics;

(ii) Finances;

(iii) Leadership;

(iv) Scheduling;

(v) Extracurricular offerings;

(vi) Overall school climate, including bullying; and

(vii) Other areas which the school district deems

relevant.



(B) Results of the comprehensive online survey shall be summarized by the school district and included in the school district's comprehensive improvement plan, including how specific identified needs discovered as a result of the comprehensive online survey will be addressed by the school district.
