## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REPEAL THE REQUIREMENT TO PREPARE A SUPPLEMENTAL MOTORCYCLE TRAFFIC ACCIDENT REPORT FOR A TRAFFIC ACCIDENT INVOLVING A MOTORCYCLE OR OTHER SIMILAR MOTOR-DRIVEN CYCLE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO REPEAL THE REQUIREMENT TO PREPARE A SUPPLEMENTAL MOTORCYCLE TRAFFIC ACCIDENT REPORT FOR A TRAFFIC ACCIDENT INVOLVING A MOTORCYCLE OR OTHER SIMILAR MOTOR-DRIVEN CYCLE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-53-202(d), concerning the requirement for the preparation of a supplemental motorcycle traffic accident report for a traffic accident involving a motorcycle, is repealed.

~~(d) In all traffic accidents involving motorcycles, motor-driven cycles, motorized bicycles, or any other two-wheeled or three-wheeled motor vehicle, all written reports of the accident shall be supplemented with a motorcycle traffic accident report.~~

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-53-206(c), concerning creation of motorcycle traffic accident report forms by the Department of Arkansas State Police, is repealed.

~~(c) The motorcycle traffic accident report shall be made upon forms approved and supplied by the Department of Arkansas State Police, with the~~

~~concurrence of the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department.~~

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 27-53-304(b), concerning motorcycle traffic accident reports is repealed.

~~(b) The motorcycle traffic accident report shall be made upon forms approved and supplied by the Department of Arkansas State Police, with the concurrence of the Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department.~~
