AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE STATE-SUPPORTED INSTITUTIONS OF
HIGHER EDUCATION TO DESIGNATE SPECIFIED SMOKING AREAS
OR ZONES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AUTHORIZE STATE-SUPPORTED INSTITUTIONS
OF HIGHER EDUCATION TO DESIGNATE
SPECIFIED SMOKING AREAS OR ZONES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 6-60-804, concerning prohibitions on smoking at state-supported institutions of higher education, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

(d)(1) A state-supported institution of higher education may designate within the boundaries of its campus a specified area or zone in which smoking is allowed for individuals.

(2) Each state-supported institution of higher education shall provide a relevant communication to students and employees of the institution identifying the specified area or zone.
