AN ACT CONCERNING THE ANALYSIS AND STORAGE OF DNA
SAMPLES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

CONCERNING THE ANALYSIS AND STORAGE OF
DNA SAMPLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 12-12-1112(b), concerning when the results of a DNA profile in the database may be made available, is amended to read as follows:

(b) The results of the DNA profile of individuals in the database shall be made available:

(1) To criminal justice agencies or to approved crime laboratories which serve these criminal justice agencies; ~~or~~

(2) Upon written or electronic request and in furtherance of an official investigation of a criminal offense~~+~~; or

(3) Upon the filing of a motion and a showing of good cause by a defendant in a criminal or juvenile delinquency case, to the defendant in the criminal or juvenile delinquency case in order to determine whether a particular person or persons other than the defendant is included or excluded with regard to evidence in the criminal or juvenile delinquency case.
