## For An Act To Be Entitled

TO CLARIFY AND RESTORE THE LAW IN TEMPORARY TOTAL  
DISABILITY BENEFIT DETERMINATIONS AND EMPLOYEE  
MISCONDUCT AS A BASIS FOR TERMINATION UNDER THE  
WORKERS' COMPENSATION LAW THAT RESULTED FROM  
INITIATED ACT NO. 4 OF 1948; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

TO CLARIFY AND RESTORE THE LAW IN  
TEMPORARY TOTAL DISABILITY BENEFIT  
DETERMINATIONS AND EMPLOYEE MISCONDUCT AS  
A BASIS FOR TERMINATION UNDER THE  
WORKERS' COMPENSATION LAW THAT RESULTED  
FROM INITIATED ACT NO. 4 OF 1948.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this act is to restore the law and consistency in workers' compensation law concerning temporary total disability benefit determinations and employee misconduct as a basis for termination under the workers' compensation law that resulted from Initiated Act No. 4 of 1948.
