For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT LIMITING THE LIABILITY OF A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY FOR ACTS COMMITTED BY A CERTIFIED LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IN THE AGENCY'S EMPLOYMENT WHILE THE OFFICER IS WORKING FOR A PRIVATE THIRD PARTY OUTSIDE OF HIS OR HER NORMAL WORKING HOURS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

LIMITING THE LIABILITY OF A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY FOR ACTS COMMITTED BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER IN THE AGENCY'S EMPLOYMENT WHILE THE OFFICER IS WORKING FOR A THIRD PARTY OUTSIDE OF HIS OR HER NORMAL WORKING HOURS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 16, Chapter 120, Subchapter 1, is amended to add an additional section to read as follows:

16-120-106. Limitation of liability for local law enforcement agencies.

A local law enforcement agency has tort immunity for any act by an employee of the local law enforcement agency who is a certified law enforcement officer that occurs while the employee is working for a third party outside of the:

(1) Employee's normal working hours; or

(2) Scope of the employee's employment with the local law



enforcement agency.
