AN ACT TO AMEND THE REQUIREMENTS FOR NOTIFICATION TO
LAW ENFORCEMENT CONCERNING A MOTOR VEHICLE ACCIDENT
INVOLVING PROPERTY DAMAGE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

TO AMEND THE REQUIREMENTS FOR

INVOLVING PROPERTY DAMAGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-53-202(a), concerning requirements for notification to law enforcement of a motor vehicle accident resulting in injury, death or property damage, is amended to read as follows:

(a) The driver of a motor vehicle involved in an accident resulting in injury to or death of ~~any a~~ a person or ~~total~~ property damage ~~to an apparent extent of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or more~~ shall notify the nearest law enforcement agency immediately. All persons involved in the accident shall make themselves readily available to the investigating agency's officer or officers if the accident results in:

- (1) Injury or death to a person;
- (2) Property damage in the amount of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or more to a motor vehicle involved in the accident; or
- (3) Damage to the property of another person not involved in the accident.
