AN ACT CONCERNING THE "JOURNEY" PROVISION IN REGARD  
TO THE CRIMINAL OFFENSE OF CARRYING A WEAPON; AND FOR  
OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

CONCERNING THE "JOURNEY" PROVISION IN  
REGARD TO THE CRIMINAL OFFENSE OF  
CARRYING A WEAPON.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

*SECTION 1. DO NOT CODIFY. Legislative intent.*

*It is not the intent of the General Assembly with this act to amend the elements of the criminal offense of carrying a weapon, § 5-73-120.*

*SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 5-73-119(e)(7), concerning the instance when it is permissible to carry a handgun when on a journey, is amended to read as follows:*

(7) The person is on a journey beyond the ~~county~~ township in which the person lives, unless the person is eighteen (18) years of age or less;

*SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 5-73-120(b)(3), concerning the definition of "journey" for the offense of carrying a weapon, is amended to read as*



follows:

(3) "Journey" means travel beyond the ~~county~~ township in which a person lives; and
