For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A MINIMUM STANDARD FOR THE STRUCTURE OF A PLACE OF BUSINESS FOR THE OPERATION OF A TOW COMPANY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO REQUIRE THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A MINIMUM STANDARD FOR THE STRUCTURE OF A PLACE OF BUSINESS FOR THE OPERATION OF A TOW COMPANY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-50-1203(e)(1)(I), concerning, the requirements for the structure and operation of the place of business for a towing company, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

(I) The board shall set a minimum standard for the structure of the place of business and storage facility utilized for the daily operation of a tow company licensed and regulated under this subsection. The place of business shall utilize:

- (1) A location easily accessible by the public;
- (2) An appropriate and secure filing system for business records;
- (3) Clear and visible front and rear location signage that is:
 - (i) A minimum of four (4) feet x six (6) feet in size;
 - (ii) Displaying the name, physical address, and a



telephone number of the tow company; and hours of operation, and a telephone number easily accessible to the public.
