**For An Act To Be Entitled**

AN ACT TO EXEMPT CERTAIN ADVERTISING AND PROMOTION  
TAX RECORDS FROM BEING RELEASED UNDER THE FREEDOM OF  
INFORMATION ACT OF 1967; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

**Subtitle**

TO EXEMPT CERTAIN ADVERTISING AND  
PROMOTION TAX RECORDS FROM BEING RELEASED  
UNDER THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT OF  
1967.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 25-19-105(b), concerning records not open to the public under the Freedom of Information Act of 1967, § 25-19-101 et seq., is amended to add an additional subdivision to read as follows:

(20)(A) Information related to taxes collected by particular entities under § 26-74-501 et seq.; the Advertising and Promotion Commission Act, § 26-75-601 et seq.; and § 26-75-701 et seq.

(B) However, this exemption does not apply to information or other records regarding the total taxes collected under § 26-74-501 et seq.; the Advertising and Promotion Commission Act, § 26-75-601 et seq.; and § 26-75-701 et seq. in the county or municipality as a whole.
