## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING ANATOMICAL GIFTS  
OF MINORS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

### Subtitle

TO AMEND THE LAW CONCERNING ANATOMICAL  
GIFTS OF MINORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 20-17-1202(6), concerning the definition of a term used in the Revised Arkansas Anatomical Gift Act, is amended to read as follows:

(6) "Document of gift" means a donor card or other record used to make an anatomical gift. The term includes a statement or symbol on a driver's license, identification card, birth certificate, or donor registry.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 20-17-1206, concerning the revocation of an anatomical gift, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

(f)(1) A minor child whose parents certified that he or she is an organ donor on his or her birth certificate may revoke his or her anatomical gift under this section.

(2) The minor child may authorize a statement or symbol to be imprinted on his or her driver's license or identification card, indicating the withdrawal of his or her anatomical gift.

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 20-18-401, concerning information provided

on a birth certificate, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as follows:

(i) A certificate of birth of a child shall have a section where a parent of the child may certify that his or her child is an organ donor.
